Sustainability of campus mobile heritage experiences is a persistent challenge that is rarely considered from the beginning

Just because you built it, doesn't mean they are going to use it.

Campus mobile heritage experiences shouldn't be static. Instead, they should reflect changing knowledge about the university and broader university themes

Campus mobile heritage experiences provide an opportunity to bring to light complicated (and often uncomfortable) aspects of university heritage.
